# HOME HEALTH Checklist

#### YARD AND BACKYARD

- Aerate the lawn
- Trim shrubs and trees twice a year
- Fertilize lawn once a year in the spring
- Drain and winterize exterior hoses and in-ground sprinklers in the Fall to prepare for winter
- Wrap insulation around outdoor faucets and pipes in unheated garages in cold months

## **EXTERIOR OF HOME**

- Remove any built-up debris and leaves from the gutters
- Touch up trim and siding with paint
- Power-wash windows and siding
- Inspect the roof for missing, loose, or damaged shingles or leaks
- Seal any cracks or gaps in windows and doors with caulk or weatherstripping

### **INTERIOR OF HOME**

- Deep clean carpets and wash rugs
- Dust ceiling fans, shelves, and hard-to-reach places
- Scrub or reseal grout
- Touch up any scuffs, scratches, or holes in the walls
- Check for any signs of water damage or pests

#### **FIXTURES AND APPLIANCES**

- Clean ovens and ranges
- Clean garbage disposal by grinding ice cubes and flush with hot water and baking soda
- Vacuum refrigerator and freezer coils, empty and clean drip trays
- Run a clean cycle on the dishwasher
- Check the fireplace for damage or hazards, and have it
- professionally inspected once a year
- Clean fireplace flues
- Vacuum lint from the dryer vent

# HVAC SYSTEM

- Change your AC filter once a month
- Clean furnace filter
- Vacuum heat registers and vents
- Make sure indoor and outdoor air vents are unblocked
- Schedule a professional inspection twice a year

## **ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT**

- Test outlets
- Inspect electrical cords for wear
- Check smoke and CO alarms and replace the batteries once a year
- Check the home monitoring system to ensure it's working properly
- Check SD cards for security cameras

# ATTIC/BASEMENT/CRAWLSPACE

- Check for rodents, bats, roaches, and termites and set any necessary traps
- Check insulation around any windows, doors, floorboards, and walls, and repair with caulk or weatherproof tape if necessary
- Check for signs of water damage and call a plumber if you find any potential leaks

#### PLUMBING

- Check water softener and replenish salt
- Flush hot water from the water heater to remove accumulated sediment
- · Check the water heater for leaks
- · Clean faucet aerators and showerheads to remove mineral deposits
- Check washer hose connectionsInspect under bathroom and kitchen sinks for leaks
- Inspect under bathroom and kitchen sinks
- Examine pipes for leaks or clogs
- Contact a plumber to replace any damaged or corroded pipes or to line your plumbing
- Schedule a professional plumbing inspection once a year
